Tarrant County College Accomplishments under the Leadership of Chancellor Erma Johnson Hadley

Increased student enrollment by an average of 2,700 students per year since 2010

Student graduation increased from 4,760 students per year in 2010 to 7,215 in 2015

Initiated involvement in the Achieving the Dream initiative, and established TCC as a Leader College for best practices among community colleges

Awarded more than \$12 million in state and federal grants to assist in the implementation of student success initiatives

Launched a Transition to College Success course for all first-time-in-college students

Opened the first full TCC Weekend College to provide greater access and service to students, resulting in 5,706 enrollments the first semester

Developed an Early College High School program in partnership with local school districts

Became the only Texas college or university to receive national funding from the AARP Foundation as part of its BACK TO WORK 50+ program to assist older students overcome barriers to entering full-time employment

Developed and funded Faculty Academy to address the comprehensive professional development needs of TCC faculty

Initiated a comprehensive project management process on all capital improvement projects resulting in more than \$10 million in savings since 2010

Implemented online broadcasting of all Board of Trustees meetings to provide unlimited access to Board governance decisions
